



The MNOSHA Partnership was established in 2012 between ABC of MN/ND and MNOSHA. Participating contractors are expected to show dedication to reducing injuries on the jobsite and improving lines of communication between all levels of the company with regard to safety.

Goals of the program

- **To reduce** by 3 percent annually the number of injuries, illnesses and fatalities affecting participant employers.
- **To increase** the number of construction contractors that implement effective safety and health programs and provide effective safety and health training.
- **To recognize** those contractors where managers and employees work together to develop safety and health management systems that go beyond basic compliance.
- **To promote** open lines of communication between MNOSHA and the construction industry in pursuit of safety.
